1. Water Bodies→ Using a BLUE colored pencil <u>label</u> the following as it is written:

South China Sea

Yellow Sea

Sea of Japan

Brahmaputra River (also trace its path in BLUE)

Huang He (also trace its path in BLUE)

Yangtze (also trace its path in BLUE)

2. *Mountain Ranges*→ Using a BROWN colored pencil make ^^^ marks to show each mountain range then <u>label</u> each of the following in BLACK colored pencil:

Himalavas

Hindu Kush

Eastern Ghats

Western Ghats

- 3. <u>Color</u> the Ganges Plain & the North China Plain with a GREEN colored pencil and <u>label</u> them with BLACK.
- 4. <u>Color</u> the Deccan Plateau & the Plateau of Tibet with a YELLOW colored pencil and <u>label</u> them with BLACK.
- 5. <u>Color</u> the Gobi Desert with an ORANGE colored pencil and <u>label</u> it with BLACK.
- 6. Mark these mountain peaks with a PURPLE colored pencil using a small triangle and label them with BLACK:

- 7. Mark the Ring of Fire with a series of RED ORANGE *** colored pencil marks and label it with BLACK.
- 8. <u>Color</u> the Indochina Peninsula with a PINK/MAGENTA colored pencil and <u>label</u> it with BLACK.
- 9. Using a ruler draw and label the EQUATOR and TROPIC OF CANCER with a RED colored pencil.
- 10. Color any remaining areas of Asia LIGHT BROWN.
