2.	Mountain Ranges→ Using a BROWN colored pencil make ^^^ marks to show each mountain range then <a href="label">label</a> each of the following in BLACK colored pencil:  Ural Mountains  Caucasus Mtns.  Hindu Kush
	Kazahk Uplands
	Sayan Mtns. (You don't have to write Eastern or Western)
3.	<u>Color</u> both the West Siberian Plain & the Central Russian Upland with a <b>GREEN</b> colored pencil and <u>label</u> them with <b>BLACK</b> .
4.	Color both the Central Siberian Plain & the STEPPES YELLOW and label them with BLACK.
5.	Peninsulas → Color each peninsula the color listed and then label each with a BLACK colored pencil:  Kamchatka ORANGE Chukchi VIOLET or PURPLE Kola RED
